Practical semester at the University of Bremen for teaching at primary schools

Framework conditions for the practical semester: Practical part in school

1. Internship duration of at least 16 weeks
2. usually 25 hours/week of attendance at the school (at least 15 hours/week on at least 3 days) including preparation and follow-up times
3. Supervision by trained teachers (mentors), qualified in the specific subjects
4. Self-designed lessons of 7-8 hours per subject in the presence of the mentor incl. pre- and debriefing. If one of the subjects is inclusive education, the following arrangement applies:
 - Self-designed teaching unit in one of the subjects for 10-12 hours with a focus on inclusive pedagogy or heterogeneity (or a combination of both)
 - Additional self-designed teaching unit of 4-6 hours with a focus on inclusive pedagogy and a subject of free choice
 - In the second subject a teaching unit of 7-8 hours
5. active participation in school life
6. Participation in extracurricular events and ideally also conferences, if allowed by the school regulations or meeting management
7. The school confirms successful implementation of the school internship: After completion of the internship, the students receive an internship certificate from the school, in which their performance and their development progress in the internship are assessed.

The practical semester abroad is integrated into the curriculum of teacher training at the University of Bremen through preparatory and follow-up events as well as virtual accompanying formats.
